



## Science:

During the Spring term, we will be studying animals and their habitats. This will include looking at different climates around the world and, more specifically, different types of tunnelling animals in Britain. We will also look at life cycles and will be setting up a wormery.



## Computing:

In computing this term, pupils will be studying how computers simulate the real world. Through the exploration of Google Maps we will be locating our school and the surrounding roads and facilities. We will learn that to retrieve information we need to input instructions into the computer first.




## Music

This term, the children will be developing their skills in pitch, understanding and recognising a change of pitch. They will also learn about beat and rhythm patterns using their own body percussion, voices and instruments.



## RE:

In RE we are learning about Judaism. This will involve learning about the daily life of a Jew, the Torah and religious occasions.



## PE:

During the Spring term, pupils will continue to have their two PE sessions each week.

Pupils will be taught gymnastics and dynamic and static balances.

During gymnastic lessons, children will demonstrate their gymnastics skills, such as rolls, shapes and jumps whilst also learning how to safely use gymnastic apparatus.

Pupils will be taught how to balance along apparatus by lifting their legs to 90 degrees as they walk and then hold a balance by standing on their toes, standing still along a narrow beam and then do this whilst catching an object.



## PSHE:

In PSHE we will be learning how to recognise feelings and how to cope with our own feelings. We will also be looking at how to cope when you are not very good at something. All of these areas will be learned through drama and other activities.
