Year 3 Learning Journey



French:

We are lucky to have a French native amongst the year 3 team, so this term, we decided all children should have the opportunity to learn French with Miss Zerr. She is mainly focussing on re-visiting the basic greeting sentences, such as Bonjour, comment t'appelles tu? And quel age as tu? The children are perfecting their French accent and practising their sentences in song, games, and communicating with our French mascot, Lune!

Science:

During the spring term, we will be studying animals including humans. This will include looking at food chains and how we fit into them. This will include the terms predator, prey, apex predator, After half term we will be looking at light and what plants need to grow successfully.



PE:

During the spring term, pupils will continue to have their two PE sessions each week.

One session will be based on gymnastics where children will learn different skills through mat work.

They will also be doing multi-skills activities which will include a variety of ball games and team games such as dodgeball and basketball.

Maths:

We will be covering addition, subtraction, multiplication and division this half term. We are using concrete objects, pictorial diagrams and moving towards completing tasks in the abstract. Within each session we also complete a reasoning activity to practise using the skills we have learned.

Music

This term, the children will be developing their skills by playing tunes based on the pentatonic scale. They will also learn to focus on beat, timing and rhythm. Combining melodic and rhythmic patterns with work based on staff notation.



PSHE:

In PSHE we will be learning about reaching our goals and learning behaviours, through growth mind set. We are learning how to challenge ourselves and understand how our feelings can affect our lives.



RE:

In RE we are learning about Lent and the build up to Easter within the Christian Church Calendar following the Northamptonshire SACRE document.
