2019 Autumn Topic




During our learning journey for Autumn A, the children will be learning about others and ourselves. We will be learning about how we grow and transition from babies to adults. The children will be learning about the Human Body, how it works and how we can look after our bodies. We will be starting P.E and be learning about how exercise effects our bodies.

Here are some of the books that we will share and explore with your child this term.



This term we will start to learn our RWI letter sounds. Ask your child about Fred!



Personal, Social, Emotional Development; we will be learning to;

- try new activities independently and select resources independently.
- get dressed independently for P.E
- know routines of the school day
- think about the feelings of others

Communication and Language; we will be learning to;

- take part in circle time
- learning to talk about myself using describing words such as tall, short
- asking questions to get to know my friends in my new class.
- talking about my family
- listen to stories and rhymes

Physical development; we will be learning to;

- travel in a variety of ways
- explore movements with my body
- move with confidence, control and safety
- develop my hand control
- learn about a healthy lifestyle
- learn to balance on different parts of my body
- use a range of tools safely

Understanding the World; we will be learning to;

- talk about similarities and differences between my friends
- use my five senses to investigate area around them
- find out about the different parts of the body.

Expressive Art and Design; we will be learning to;

- explore sounds and move to music
- play a variety of instruments
- paint and draw self portraits
- sing familiar songs
- name and mix colours

Thinking Skills and Personal Capabilities

We will seek every opportunity to develop our ability and willingness to follow our school values: Show integrity, be aspirational, be empathetic, be creative, be respectful and be responsible.

Literacy

We will be learning to;

- recognise and write my name.
- read a range of fiction books
- know the different sounds that letters make (phonics)
- write familiar words such as mum, dad
- write for a purpose e.g. making lists, labelling pictures.
- re-tell stories
- talk about characters in story books

Maths

We will be learning to;

- count, recognize and order numbers to at least 10.
- match numbers to quantities of groups to at least 10.
- say the number one more/less than a given number up to 10.
- relate addition to combining two or more groups of objects.
- Learn the names of 2D shapes.
