

Superheroes

Year 1

During our learning journey for Autumn A, the children will be learning about Superheroes and what it means to be a Superhero. We will be exploring and learning about everyday Superheroes and how they help and support us. The children will explore and research back in time about previous superheroes and how they have made a difference today. The children will be getting the opportunity to meet some real life superheroes of today in person. The children will be learning about the Human Body, how it works and how we can look after our bodies. They will be exploring seasonal changes and discover how this affects the change in climate.



As **Writers**, we will be writing recounts of our findings and retelling stories from different characters' aspects. We will be looking at Superhero themed books. The children will be writing non-fiction pieces about superheroes based around characters from different tales.

As **Readers**, we will be enjoying Superkid and Supertato. In addition to this, we will be looking at a range of fiction and non-fiction books based around Superheroes.

As **Geographers**, we will be exploring different weather and climate changes over the countries and throughout the year.

As **Design Technologists**, we will be using their senses and tasting foods. The children will be encouraged to use adjectives to describe the taste.

As **Historians**, we will be researching and studying historical figures and recognise how they are still seen as superheroes today.

As **Artists**, we will be creating our own masks and creating a 3D model of a hero.

Year 1 Learning Journey



Maths:

This half term we are exploring place value up to 20.

We are learning addition and subtraction and exploring the different vocabulary for addition and subtraction and learning the symbols.

Science:

During Autumn A, we will be studying the human body and seasonal changes. The children will be exploring and investigating different parts of the body. They will learn about fair testing and we will be incorporating Maths into our lessons. The children will be learning about the weather and how it changes within the seasons.



PE:

During the Autumn A term, the children will be taught to explore different ways of using a ball, explore ways to send a ball or other equipment. Retrieve and stop a ball using different parts of the body. Play a variety of running and avoiding games. Learn why they enjoy playing games and physical activities. Talk about what our bodies do during exercise.

Computing:

In computing this half term, the children will be learning how to use the different tools within 2simple, creating pictures and posters linked to superheroes. They will learn how to control a mouse and save work and also be learning about E-safety and how to keep safe online and what to do if you don't feel safe online through Home Learning World.



Music

This term, the children will be exploring shape and melody in music. We will explore elements through Music Express. They will be exploring sounds through different musical instruments, to create Superhero sounds.



RE:

In RE we are learning about places in Christianity and questions about God. The children will be learning about Harvest and how we celebrate as a community.



PSHE:

In PSHE we will be learning about positive behaviours, how to be assertive, how to calm down and relax. We will be learning about the Exeter School values. Our likes, dislikes, and that we don't have to be the same as everyone else. The children will begin to understand about making choices and how their reactions affect others.
